From Canada's poorest neighborhood to the slums of Indonesia, Jason Porterfield (MA in Theology, Fuller Seminary) has lived in places most people would rather avoid. His passion is to cultivate God's shalom wherever it is painfully absent and to help churches embrace their peacemaking vocation. Jason is currently writing his first book, Resurrecting Peace: Recovering Holy Week's Forgotten Peacemaker, which trains readers in Jesus's approach to peacemaking by examining how he contended for peace on each day of Holy Week.

In 2007, Jason joined Servants, an international network of Christian communities living and ministering amongst the urban poor. He was a founding member of the Vancouver team, started a new team in Indonesia, and oversaw the North America sending office through 2015. Today, Jason lives with his wife Laura (daughter of David and Joyce Byrne) and their three kids (Mika, Luke and Jono) in Friendswood, TX. When he's not hanging out with family or volunteering with the Student Ministries at Friendswood Friends Church, you'll find him writing, gardening or drinking coffee.

A closing Community Worship Celebration will be held at 10:30 a.m. in the Ross-Ellis Center Auditorium on Sunday morning, July 28th. Every member of the EFC-MAYM family is encouraged to attend this final gathering of Ministry Conference 2019. Congregations are encouraged to release their pastors and their congregations (where possible) in order to allow as many as possible to participate in this service. Live video streaming of the Community Service will be available.

CHILDREN'S CONFERENCE

All Children's Conference sessions (ages 0-6th grade) will be held at Haviland Friends Church and directed by KC Lingafelter. Child registrations include scheduled meals. Children may arrive fifteen minutes before each scheduled Ministry Conference session and should be picked up promptly after each session for meals with their family. Children's Conference sessions will last from Thursday afternoon to Saturday evening. There will not be Children's Conference on Sunday morning during the Community Service. Families with registered children will be sent further details no later than a week prior to the conference.

CONFERENCE DETAILS

CONFERENCE CHECK-IN

Thursday: Check-in will be at the lobby of Broadhurst Student Center between 1:00-2:00, 4:00-5:30 and 9:00-10:00. Check in will not be available during Ministry Team Meetings and the 7:00 General Session.

Friday-Saturday: Check-in and dorm key pick-up will take place at the Conference Registration desk in the lobby of the Ross-Ellis Center before and between sessions.

All people staying in the dorms should check out of their rooms prior to attending the Sunday morning Community Gathering at 10:30.

MEALS

All meals (except the Friends Women Breakfast – see that section for details) will be served in the dining room of Broadhurst Student Center. The first meal served is Thursday dinner at 5:30 p.m. The last meal served is Sunday morning breakfast for those who are registered.

CONFERENCE PRICING

Early bird registration price for adults is \$135, and \$100 for the Children's Conference (0-6th grade). Registration pricing increases by \$20 for each event after 11:59 on June 30, 2019. So prices for Adults beginning July 1st will be \$155 and for children \$120. No registrations will be received after Wednesday, July 17th, in order for staff to compile meal numbers and housing assignments. Daily commuter pricing with meals (Thursday - \$20, Friday - \$60 and Saturday - \$60) are also available. Daily Commuter pricing without meals will be available this year for Friday and Saturday if you want to attend workshops and sessions for \$20 a day. Evening sessions are always open to anyone without registration.

HOUSING

Lodging will be facilitated in Lewis and Lemmon Halls on the Barclay campus. Rooms will be available from Thursday night through Saturday night. You must register before July 17th to reserve a room, and they will be provided on a first come, first served basis until rooms are full. There are no elevators available, so please let Janet Penna know if you need to be on the first floor. Bring your own bedding/pillow, bath towels and personal items. Each room has 2 twin beds and a shared bathroom with another guest room. Please indicate when you register your preference for roommate and suite mate. We will make every effort to accommodate your requests. Motels are available in Greensburg and Pratt if you want to make your own arrangements.

CONFERENCE OFFERING

The Ministry Conference Offerings taken at each general session for 2019 will be designated for two projects, one will have a home missions/local church planting focus and one will have a global missions focus. The Home Missions half will go for our new missional outreach in Topeka, Kansas with Barclay graduates Jesse and Savannah (Linville) Waller and boys. Jesse is employed at a state prison as a Chaplain and Savannah is busy as a homemaker. They are both passionate and have a vision to have a Friends presence in Topeka. The global mission half will go to fund leadership training for Burundi pastors and church leaders. Many times rural pastors in Burundi have very little bibilical and leadership training for teaching and shepherding a congregation available to them.
