- John 6:66 From this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him.
- John 6:68 Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life."
- John 7:7 The world cannot hate you, but it hates me because I testify that its works are evil.
- John 7:15 The Jews were amazed and asked, "How did this man get such learning without having been taught?"
- John 7:30 At this they tried to seize him, but no one laid a hand on him, because his hour had not yet come.
