Childcare is available during all general sessions, by request. Please indicate this request in the online registration process.

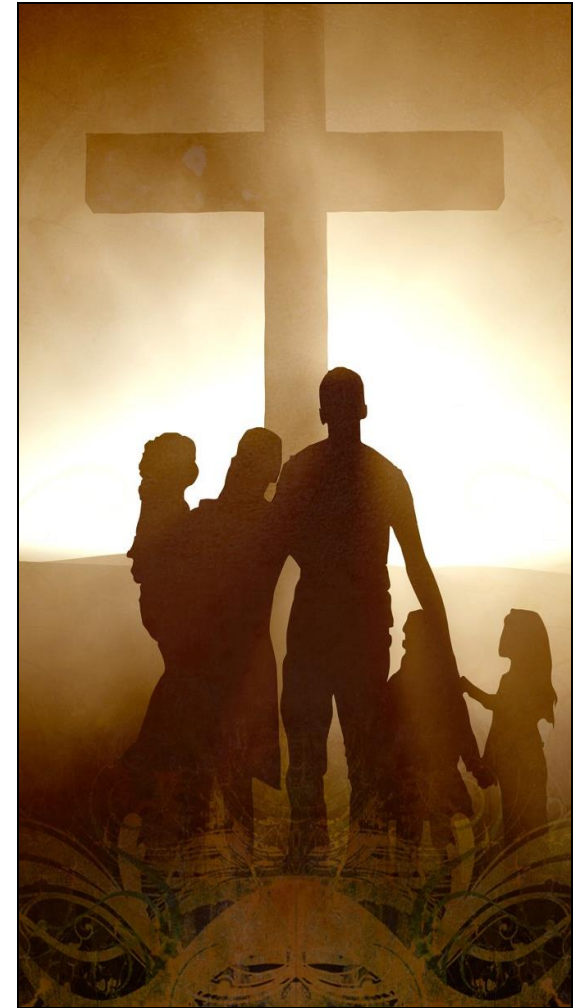
