Devoted Followers of Jesus as Lord - 2 Corinthians 4:5 – Acts 18:5


The following Job description reflects qualifications as determined by our congregation:

- 3. Fosters leadership by including, empowering, and equipping the congregation.
- 4. Committed to gifts-based ministry, helping the congregation identify their spiritual gifts for use in ministry.
- 5. Supports the Northwest Yearly Meeting of Friends and its <u>Faith and Practice</u> and has a good working knowledge of Quaker history and theology.
- 6. Personally engaged in the community, working with community groups and faith-based organizations leading to individual growth and congregational growth.
- 7. Emphasizes the application of the Christian gospel to local issues, planning with the congregation for appropriate strategies for witnessing and action.
- 8. Helps connect the gifts and capacities of the congregation to the needs of persons outside the church—creating space for new persons to enter into and connect to the congregation.
- Provides appropriate counseling and pastoral care for those within and outside the congregation and makes referrals as needed.
- 10. Visits those in hospitals, emergency situations, and long-term care facilities—informing the congregation of opportunities to provide mutual support and care.

Sherwood, Oregon

Brief Description:

Sherwood is a growing city in Washington County, Oregon. Located in the southeast corner of the county, it is a residential community in the Tualatin Valley, about 16 miles southwest of Portland. Although a comparably small city in Washington County, many close neighbor cities provide exciting opportunities for service and community outreach.



The city of Sherwood lies about 52 miles from beautiful Mt. Hood, with many activities to enjoy year around. Sherwood also lies about 70 miles from the beautiful Oregon Coast. The trip to the coast takes you through beautiful wine country.

As for ties with Northwest Yearly Meeting, Sherwood is about 8 miles from Newberg, OR, the home of the Yearly Meeting offices. Newberg is also the home of George Fox University and Camp Tilikum which are both a product of NWYM. A second camp with ties to NWYM, Twin Rocks Friends Camp, is located in Rockaway Beach, OR and is about 90 miles from Sherwood.

Sherwood is a family-friendly community with many opportunities for ministry and adventure. It holds events such as Cruisin' Sherwood, the Robin Hood Festival, and Music on the Green, but also offers proximity to many hikes, sporting events, and great food. Sherwood recently opened the largest high school in Oregon in 2021, currently holding around 1,800 students and nearby George Fox University also holds another 4,300 (2021) students. These are great opportunities for our church.
