Church Description & Vision:

Sacramento Friends Community Church is a pastor-led programmed Quaker Meeting in East Sacramento. This Church has a big heart for serving the broader community including outreach to the unhoused population, supporting refugee resettlement, and planning activities to minister to the established neighborhood surrounding the church building. Sacramento Friends is demographically diverse - age, economically, politically and racially. Post-COVID, there is an average of 30 attendees each Sunday. Currently, there is a weekly Prayer Meeting, a monthly potluck, Sunday School classes and a volunteer-led Children's Church. The Meeting is committed to Spirit-led Silent Worship, commiting one Sunday per month to Quaker Communion.

The facilities consist of a Multi Building Church Property with a parsonage next door. Church facilities consist of a 12 room education building including a large social hall with kitchen and fireplace and a sanctuary with an organ, Steinway piano, and good sound system, and a full-basement social hall. Property is regularly used by various community organizations and faith groups throughout the week including various 12-step programs, the Boy Scouts, an Indian Christian Group, a Spanish-speaking Christian group and others on a semi-regular basis.

Our vision is to grow our church family and continue serving various needs within our church and in the larger community. Over the years numbers have dwindled especially due to members moving out of State, but the heart and commitment to serving Christ and His people is alive. We are seeking a pastor that is spirit-led, committed to Quaker theology and skilled in both outreach and member care.

- Visits shut ins and congregants who cannot attend
- Sheppards formally and informally congregants and members in need of counsel
- Presides over weddings, memorials and funerals of those connected to the congregation.
- Provides premarital and marital counseling
- Oversee and secure the facilities; collaboration with organizations that use the building during the week
- Various duties as needed or assigned
