What to Bring to Camp

- ☐ Final Registration Payment
- ☐ Bible
- ☐ Flashlight (not your phone)
- ☐ Refillable Water Bottle
- ☐ Bedding/Pillow
- ☐ Toiletries
 - Shower Towel
 - Pool Towel
 - Soap
 - Shampoo
 - Deodorant
 - Toothbrush
 - Toothpaste
- ☐ Insect Repellant
- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Modest Clothing (See Dress Code Below)
- ☐ Shoes (TENNIS SHOES are needed for most activities)
 - Pool Shoes (flips flops to wear to and from pool)
- ☐ Clothes/Shoes That Can Get Dirty
- ☐ Modest Swimsuit

- ☐ Money for Canteen (snacks, souvenirs, etc)
- ☐ Money for Offerings (for CQH or EFM projects)
- ☐ Medicine (must be clearly marked with camper's name and type of medicine and given to the Camp Nurse upon check-in)

- Cell Phones

- Fireworks
- Valuables
- Weapons of any kind

Dress Code

We ask that you pack and wear modest clothing and understand this dress code applies to both males and females who attend.

- T-shirts, shorts, and tennis shoes are great for most activities.
- Modest shorts/skirts. If in doubt about length, please ask a trusted adult or contact the camp director.
- Leggings and biker shorts must be covered by shorts, a skirt, a dress, or a long t-shirt
- No bare midriffs.
- No visible boxers, briefs, or bralettes.
- No clothing with references to drugs, alcohol, sex, or profanity.
- No low-cut tops or tanks in the front or on the sides.
- Accepted swimsuits include: tankinis, one pieces, modest trunks, or bikinis covered by a colored shirt. Please refrain from wearing speedos or uncovered bikinis
